

This year's edition of the colloquium aims to provide an interdisciplinary approach, from multiple perspectives, to ancient civilizations (mainly, but not limited to Greek and Roman civilization). From this perspective, the main focus

is on the multiple roles of the Muses: in the pantheon, in mythology, in science, culture but especially in the art of these two Ancient civilizations.

The great epics belonging to these two cultures begin with a verbal invocation of the Muses. Therefore, the 14th edition of our colloquium is academically challenging, both for the organisers and the participants. It must be said that such a theme is related to both art and science, as the Muses were the patrons of multiple different fields of study/domains. Additionally, the theme is new and unique for the study of ancient civilizations.

We suggest that those who are interested in participating approach the theme from one of the following perspectives:

or by any means deemed suitable.

The languages accepted by our international colloquium are Romanian, French, Spanish and Italian. All contributions are peer reviewed before publication.

Those who wish to participate must send a MS word document containing: paper's title, author's first name, surname and academic affiliation, an abstract of maximum 150 words, five keywords and a list of minimum six references to the adress madalinastrechie@gmail.com, until September 8th 2023.

The full article, written according to the norms which will be notified by email to all participants, must be sent until (or on) **November 1**st **2022**, to the address madalinastrechie@gmail.com. The colloquium's papers will be published in a conference proceedings volume printed at Universitaria Press, with CNCS accreditation, which will be published until the end of 2023.

The participation fee is **200 RON**, for Romanian participants, the equivalent of **42 Euro** for foreign participants. The fee can be paid through postal order, at our university's pay desk, or through bank transfer or internet banking at any of the accounts listed below, until **September 10th 2023**.
