

Professor PhD Cristiana-Nicola TEODORESCU

Cristian-Nicola TEODORESCU is a professor at the Faculty of Letters of the University of Craiova, director of the "Alexandru Piru" doctoral school. Cristiana-Nicola TEODORESCU is a PhD graduate of the University of Craiova, specialized in French Language and Literature - Romanian Language and Literature and a Master graduate in Communication at Université du Québec à Montréal, Canada (Usages familiaux de la télévision. Le cas de sept Roumains à Montréal (Family Uses of Television. The Case of Seven Romanian People in Montreal), under the coordination of Gina Stoiciu and Serge Proulx). Since 1997, she has been a Doctor of Philology at the University of Craiova. Her PhD thesis,

Patologia discursului comunist totalitar românesc (The Pathology of Romanian Totalitarian Communist Language), was coordinated by Professor Eugen Negrici.

HER MAIN RESEARCH DIRECTIONS ARE: THE ANALYSIS OF POLITICAL, MEDIA, DIDACTIC AND NUMERICAL DISCOURSE, THEORY OF COMMUNICATION, VERBAL AND NONVERBAL COMMUNICATION IN THE PUBLIC AND DIDACTIC SPACE, TERMINOLOGY.

Preoccupied by placing scientific research at the service of education, Cristiana-Nicola TEODORESCU constantly seeks to link the two spheres of activity, reflecting, in her national and international research papers and projects, on French language teaching and terminology. She is the author of four books as single author - Usages familiaux des médias et transition (1998) (Family Uses of the Media and Transition), Ouvertures à la communication (2007) (Openings to Communication), Initiation à la sémantique (2007) (Initiation to Semantics), published at Universitaria Publishing House Craiova, Patologia limbajului comunist totalitar (2000) (The Pathology of Totalitarian Communist Language) published at Scrisul Românesc Publishing House, of two translations - Carol al II-lea în exil. Documente diplomatice (2002) (Carol the Second in Exile. Diplomatic Papers), at Vremea Publishing House, and Stéphane Santerres-Sarkany, Teoria literaturii (2000) (Theory of Literature), at Cartea Românească Publishing House. She co-authored nine collective works written within the framework of international projects in which she participated as a director or as member. She has published over 150 articles and studies in Romanian and foreign reviews. Since 1999, she has been head of the TradComTerm Research Center and, since 2011, Cristiana-Nicola TEODORESCU has been the editor-inchief of the Annals of the University of Craiova. Philological Science Series. Linguistics. Cristiana-Nicola TEODORESCU coordinates the French Studies series at the Universitaria Publishing House, University of Craiova. During her 27 years of university activity, she has taught semantics, lexicology, sociolinguistics, scientific research methodology, communication theory. From 2013, she has been teaching at the International Master of Didactics of French and Languages organized under the patronage of AUF by University of Paris 3- Sorbonne, University of Geneva, University of Craiova and the Polytechnic University of Bucharest. So far, she has coordinated and supervised three joint PhD theses with Professor Laurent Gautier from University of Bourgogne, Dijon, France and she is currently coordinating other two joint PhD theses. She has initiated and coordinated several study programs at bachelor level (Traducere și terminologie - limba fraceză, limba engleză – (Translation and termonilogy – French and English, Comunicare și relații publice (Communication and Public Relations)) and several prorammes at master level (Comunicare interculturală (Intercultural Communication), Paradigme ale comunicării

organizaționale (Paradigms of Organizational Communication), Traducere și terminologie juridică (Legal Translation and Terminology)). Cristiana-Nicola TEODORESCU has held several administrative positions (Vice-Dean, Dean of the Faculty of Letters, Director of the Department of Academic Image, Vice-Rector of International Relations and Academic Image). At national and international level, Cristiana-Nicola TEODORESCU has led a sustained activity as a CNATDCU member, Philology Commission, as ARACIS expert-evaluator, as CONFRECO, BECO, AUF Vice President, as member of the ARDUF board. In 2014, she received the ARDUF Excellence Award.
