Title: centered, bold, Times New Roman, 14, line spacing: single

Author's name and affiliation: right, bold, Times New Roman, 12, line spacing: single

Abstract: justified, italics, Times New Roman, 10, line spacing: single, first line: 1 cm.

Key words: 5 key words, italics, Times New Roman, 10, line spacing: single, first line: 1 cm.

Body of paper: Normal, Times New Roman, 12, line spacing: single, justified, first line: 1 cm.

Notes: in the text, between square brackets, extended at the end of the paper with Times New Roman, normal, 10, line spacing: single, hanging 1 cm.

Bibliography: At the end of the paper with Times New Roman, normal, 10, line spacing: single, as follows: Authors's surname, author's first name, book title in italics, (translation, for foreign authors translated into Romanian), edition, issue (if applicable), place of publication, publishing house, year of publication, hanging 1 cm.
