As we move deeper into the 21st century, it is important to consider the impact of past theories, current practices, and future possibilities within these interconnected domains.

The “Retrospectives, Perspectives, and Prospectives in Linguistics, Literature, and Language Teaching” conference invites researchers to reflect on how historical foundations shape contemporary approaches and explore new, emerging trends that will outline the future of these disciplines.

We invite submissions in the following broad thematic categories, though papers addressing other relevant areas will also be considered:

  - Re-examining classic texts and linguistic models
  - Socio-historical approaches to translation studies
  - Diachronic analysis of translation norms

  - Current trends in linguistics, applied linguistics and language learning
  - New directions in literary criticism and theory
  - The intersection of technology and language teaching
  - New perspectives in cultural studies

  - Cross-cultural communication, in today's classroom
  - Revisiting linguistic theories
  - Revisiting educational methods in language teaching
  - The current landscape of translation studies
  
- ***Prospectives (Future Directions)***
  - At the crossroads between language and content: EMI and CLIL approaches
  - Innovations in language acquisition theories
  - Emerging pedagogies in language teaching
  - The impact of artificial intelligence and virtual reality in linguistics and language education
  - Translation studies in the era of artificial intelligence
  - At the crossroads between literary tradition and metamodernity
  - Literary cosmopolitanism, digimodernism and altermodernism
  - Literature between exhaustion and replenishment
