



Gabriela Rusu, pen name **Gabriela Rusu-Păsărin**, graduated from the Faculty of Philology, University of Craiova in 1981 and obtained the PhD in Philological Sciences at the University of Craiova, in 1993. Since 2004, she has been Associate Professor PhD at the National School of Political and Administrative Studies Bucharest (specialization: the history of the press and audiovisual communication). Since 2001, she has been an Associate Professor and since 2006, Associate Professor PhD at the University of Craiova, Faculty of Letters, specialization Communication and Public Relations.

Gabriela Rusu is the author of fourteen books (ten as single author, four as co-author). She has elaborated 4 courses for students. She has published 48 articles in reviews indexed in international databases magazines classified by CNCS as A or B, in proceedings of international conferences or congresses. She has published 51 articles in the Annals / Newsletters / Academic Yearbooks of Universities, Academies, in collective volumes, homage volumes, in reviews classified in C category. She has presented 137 communications at colloquia, symposiums organized by universities, by the Romanian Academy, by Research Institutes of the Romanian Academy. She has published 266 studies, essays, articles on literary topics in specialized journals with ISSN.

Professor Gabriela Rusu is the editorial board director of *Analele Universității din Craiova. Seria Comunicare. Media (Annals of the University of Craiova. Series Communication. Media)* and member of the scientific board of the review *Strategii manageriale. Managerial strategies*; member of the editorial board of *Revista Română de Istorie a Presei (the Romanian Review of the History of the Press)*, member of the editorial board of the reviews *Scrisul Românesc, Noul Literator, Carmina Balcanica. Review of South-East European Spirituality and Culture*, and senior editor at *Clipa*.

Gabriela Rusu is a member of the Scientific Committee of the International Conference organized in Galați, 2016 – 2017; member of the Scientific Committee of the National Congress of the History of the Press between 2010 and 2017; coordinator and chair of Folklorists' Colloquium – Craiova 2015; president of the organizing committee of the National Congress of the History of the Press, 2010.

She is the Director / Coordinator in 16 International Grants and Director / Coordinator in 7 Grants / National Research Contracts. She has participated in exchanges of experience and was awarded scholarships in Spain, Italy, France, Canada.

She is the vice-president of Professional Journalists' Union from Romania, the vice-president of Romanian Association of the History of the Press, member of the Association of Trainers in Journalism and Communication, of the Association of Ethnologic Sciences from Romanian, of the National Union of Radio Broadcast Creators, member of the Writers' Union from Romania, of the Romanian Association from Canada, of the Multicultural Integration Forum, Canada, Montreal.
